The School Board of Nottoway County Public Schools invites applications for the position of Superintendent.

THE COUNTY: Nottoway County is located in the south-central portion of Virginia, bounded by the counties of Amelia to the north, Dinwiddie to the east, Brunswick and Lunenburg to the south, and Prince Edward to the west. The county's land area is 315 square miles or approximately 200,000 acres with a population of 15,434. Nottoway County is a pleasant balance of open spaces and friendly towns, a wealth of natural resources, and a dynamic location for industries servicing the region, the continent and the world. THE SCHOOLS: The school division contains two primary schools (PK-4), one elementary school (5-6), one middle school (7-8), and one high school (9-12). The student enrollment of 2,006 is supported by 327 full-time employees, which includes 165 teachers. The 2018-19 operating budget for the school system is \$20,435,802 million.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Strong record of successful experience in the areas of instruction and curriculum, including an understanding of the Virginia Standards of Learning and Accreditation Standards, budget and finance, and school reform.
- A visionary team player and decisive leader who is well-organized, efficient and motivated with superior leadership and management skills who can lead the board in goal-setting, planning and policy.
- Ability to create an atmosphere of trust and mutual respect, open channels of communication, good listener, consistent, caring, supportive with staff development activities, encourages professional growth and comfortable with shared decision-making, as well as advocate school issues and needs effectively.
- Proven financial knowledge and experience and ability to effectively implement a fiscally responsible budget. Must be able to lobby for school funding on behalf of the school division, develop and explain rationale for budget to the School Board and local officials and closely supervise budget development and procedures.
- Evidence of progressive work experience preferred in one or more as a principal, teacher, superintendent, assistant superintendent and central office administrator is required. A doctorate is required. The selected candidate will be preferred to reside in Nottoway County.
